Birthday Celebrations

Everybody celebrates birthdays! No matter how sensitive you may be about religion, birthdays on the other hand, have to be celebrated. If not, you will be looked upon very strangely indeed!

Modern birthday parties and celebrations by children take their form mainly from Germany, where the birthday child received gifts, chose a menu and received a candle-ringed butter or jam cake.

The Superstitions of Birthdays

More and more, people the world over attach a certain magic to their actual date of birth...We may wear a ring with our birthstone in it for good luck. We may read our Horoscope. And when we blow out the candles on our birthday cake, we are careful to keep what we wished a secret. If we tell, of course, our wish won't come true. Why do people say, "Happy birthday!" to each other? For the good wishes of our friends and relatives are supposed to protect us from evil spirits. In many parts of the world, it is a tradition to give the birthday child pinches, smacks, spansks, thumps, bumps, or punches.

Even though they may hurt a little, they are said to be very lucky. The reason for birthday spansks is to spank away any evil spirits and send them scurrying far into the distance. Party snappers, horns, bursting balloons, firecrackers, and other noisemakers are just one more way of trying to scare off any bad-luck spirits that may be hovering about.

The Superstitious Need

There is a need to believe in something above the material world in human beings. This is built in our nature, and we can never escape it. Therefore, whenever wishing people well, we want to leave them with something good, a little extra, as an act of kindness. It is a 'nice' thing to do. Therefore, above what we can offer materially, we always 'pray' for each other, by way of saying 'Happy Birthday' or even 'good luck'. When one thinks soberly about another, he says 'good luck' as truly as a form of prayer as any other.

All these customs and traditions connected with the observance of birthdays have to do with guessing the future, good wishes for the future, good luck charms against evil spirits, and the like. All the birthday rituals, games, and ceremonies are a form of well-wishing toward the birthday child, which are supposed to work their magic in the year ahead. Birthday celebrations are superstitious in origin, tone, and attitude toward the individual.

The problem is, it is using occult powers to do it.

Candles on the Birthday Cake

The idea of putting candles on birthday cakes goes back to ancient Greece. The Greeks worshipped many gods and goddesses. Among them was one called Artemis.

Artemis was the goddess of the moon. The Greeks celebrated her birthday once each month by bringing special cakes to her temple. The cakes were round like a full moon. And, because the moon glows with light, the cakes were decorated with lighted candles. The custom of lighting candles comes from ancient times, when people were known to pray over the open fire. They were convinced that the smoke from the flames carried their thoughts, prayers, and unsaid desires to the gods. Nowadays, one blows out the candles with a specific wish in mind, hoping that it will come true.

Origin of Birthdays

The Egyptians invented birthdays as we know them today, as they were the first to come up with the 365-day year. The Egyptians were also heavily involved in magic and Astrology. Astrology and birthdays came to the Western world through Julius Caesar when he adopted the 365-day year in 45 BC. An Egyptian sorcerer called Sosigenes persuaded Julius Caesar to do so. Formally, years were marked by the harvest seasons, and there was no need to measure the year to the exact day. Birthdays are based on the Julian Calendar which we use in the West today, and are therefore based PURELY on the occult Astrology. (Western Astrology follows the twelve signs of the zodiac and the horoscope. Chinese Astrology is also popular with different signs relating to the Chinese Calendar.)

Before the Julian Calendar, the month was lunar, and the year was marked by the seasons, so you could never 'lose' a year. Spring would always come round, but the year never had the exact number of days, as the months were guided by a 30-day new moon, and occasionally there was an 'extra' month in the year.

The Julian Calendar therefore, is a system to make annual astrological celebration more convenient. We have gotten so used to it that we do not realise that anniversaries go against the more obvious lunar calendar which every ancient civilization used to follow.

Moreover, anniversaries and birthdays developed and progressed in the middle ages (“The Dark Ages”), when people believed that on a birthday a person could be helped by good spirits, or hurt by evil spirits. So, when a person had a birthday, friends and relatives gathered to protect him or her. And that’s how birthday parties (and anniversaries) began.

Anniversaries and Holidays

EVERY anniversary uses the Julian Calendar and is based on Astrology. This includes 'wedding anniversaries' and many others you could think of. Halloween is an anniversary when the line between people and the spirit realm is allegedly “thin”. The day after Halloween is a public holiday in several European countries. It is the time to reflect on lost loved ones and is considered to be the time at which the line between the world of the living and the world of the dead is at it’s thinnest and thus is considered to be the best time to talk to the dead. This may be done through ritual, or just by going to someone’s grave and leaving a flower for them.

The most important holiday in Satanism is one’s own birthday, as it is the birth date of one’s own god. It is a reminder that the Satanist, committed to true “vital existence” should consider himself the most important person in his own life.... A Satanist should celebrate his own birthday in any way he chooses, with as much pomp and ceremony as he sees fit. It is a “black mass” –Anyone who celebrates birthdays is following the satanic bible!

Christmas: Did Jesus Celebrate his Birthday?

Birthdays came from an Egyptian magician and are laced in witchcraft, horoscope, the stars etc. So don't think you are missing out by not celebrating your birthday. You may be saving yourself a lot of heartache and depression demons.

With Christmas we have Jesus himself celebrating his birthday! What a contradiction. Now he becomes a stargazer and a practiser of forbidden arts. This can never be. The child of Christmas is really “Tammuz” of the antichrist mass and cross (the son of Easter).

Every human being on earth celebrates Christmas, but what is it? Mass is a “sacrifice” – a re-enactment of the death of Jesus by Tammuz, which people call a holy day. However, this should not be done. No witchcraft spell, no pentagram, no hex, no enchantment can compare with a mass. It is the mother of abominations and witchcraft and controls everybody. Everybody that is, except the true believers. When people don't get a Christmas present they are depressed. You can be completely free right now from the curse of Christmas, simply by believing in the real Jesus Christ.

People in the world will celebrate Christmas and New Year, in combination with the witching hour (12 o'clock midnight) and wonder why you do not. People in the Roman Catholic church and all her daughter denominations will also celebrate them and wonder why you do not. Christmas and New Year is the marriage between the world and the (antichrist) church. Maybe you will have to join in to not look odd, but don't be surprised if you feel the Holy Spirit restraining you from these ungodly things. If you feel no restraint, then you may question whether you have the Holy Spirit at all.

What does the Holy Bible say?

There is really no escape. Either you follow the real Jesus Christ or you follow Idols. You only need to look at what happened on Herod’s birthday (Mark 6:16-29) and Pharaoh’s birthday (Gen 40:20-23) to know Birthdays are an opportunity for Satan to act. Why give Satan an opportunity to act, if you don’t belong to him, but belong to Jesus?

These are the only two places in the Holy Bible which mention birthdays. Both of them were opportunities for Satan to act. Please read the above passages of scripture. When Pharaoh had a birthday he hanged the chief baker. The Lord God in his wisdom in constructing the Bible, gave us a parallel case in the New Testament to compare it with. On Herod’s birthday (who is a type of Pharaoh) the greatest prophet in the world, John the Baptist was beheaded. This confirms this truth. Clearly, whenever a person celebrates a birthday, it gives Satan an opportunity to act. **This is what the bible is teaching.** Just think about it. Nobody ever celebrated their birthday in the bible. As I said before, these are the only two cases in the WHOLE BIBLE where a birthday is mentioned. Abraham didn’t. Moses didn’t. Elijah didn’t. Jesus didn’t. The Apostles didn’t. They could have, since Pharaoh did and Herod did. But they simply didn’t. So WHY DO YOU? Any church which announces birthdays is working for Satan. So if you now celebrate your birthday, you are against the Holy Bible, and have brought a witchcraft curse on your life.

Jesus Christ can set you free from depression resulting from birthdays, and he can give you salvation.
